Graduate/Undergraduate Students & Dietetic Interns

The Central Pennsylvania Dietetic Association (CPDA) would like to support students and interns studying nutrition and dietetics. Two scholarships of at least \$150 will be awarded in May 2012 to be used towards these education expenses. The recipients will be determined based on the applicant's contributions to the field, future career goals, professional references, and grades. A selection committee composed of CPDA members will evaluate each complete application and determine scholarship recipients. All student or intern applicants must be currently enrolled in an American Dietetic Association-accredited supervised practice program or in an advanced degree program that promotes the advancement of dietetics. All applicants must be members of ADA and CPDA for the current year. If the letter is included in the application packet, it should be in a sealed envelope with the writer's signature across the back flap. If the reference chooses to do so, he or she may mail the letter directly to Lindsay Seibert at the address below.

Upon receiving the scholarship:

1. Submit an article for the CPDA website. This can be based on research summary, graduate studies, or a current nutrition topic.
